The RULES OF PROCEDURE of the PHOTO CONTEST

The main aim of the Photo Contest is to show the beauty of the earth and to promote young artists.

1. The Contest is open for children and young people aged between 7 to 25.
2. The Contest begins on 25.10.2012, and finishes on 10.01.2013
3. The categories:
 - a) Man,
 - b) Nature,
 - c) Traditions,
 - d) Sport.
4. Each candidate may submit mailed entries of color or black-and-white prints, size 20x30 cm. The entries must be digitally saved on a disc at 300 DPI.
5. Participants from abroad can submit entries online. The address is:
fotografia@civitasturek.pl
6. Each entry should contain such information on the back of the print:
 - a) Name of the contest participant, age, class, address (with country) of entrant's parent or child's foster-parents, e-mail, phone number
 - b) Name of the teacher; tutor, name of the school, address, e-mail, phone number,
 - c) The place and the date when the photo was taken (it should be noticed that only photos taken in 2012 can take part in the contest)
 - d) Personally signed declaration about gratuitous transfer of the copyrights and the agreement on the retainment and processing of the personal data. (the pattern of the declaration is enclosed in Rules of Procedure).

The photos that take part in the contest could not have been published or presented in any other contests. The work must be created by the participant individually as his/her own achievement. The parents or the tutor of the contestant are obliged to stick a special declaration that the work was done personally by the contestant.

7. Where to send the works: **Katolickie Stowarzyszenie "Civitas Christiana" Turek, 10/21 Kolska Szosa 10/21, 62-701 Turek** with the note: **IV MIĘDZYNARODOWY KONKURS ARTYSTYCZNY**

The works are accepted till 10th of January 2013. The date of the work's arrival at the Organizer's office is regarded as the date of an application. The photos that will come to the office after the 10th of Jan. 2013 will not take part in the contest.

8. The organizer is not responsible for any damages or a failure to service the letter.

9. The Organizer does not send back the works. All the works become the property of the Organizer as well as the electronic version of the work.

10. The Catholic Society 'Civitas Christiana' in Turek reserves the right to the gratuitous use and transformation of the works for the needs of the contest and the exhibition in all publications, in TV presentations, in the Internet, press and in other processing means. Filling in the written declaration results in the transfer of the copyrights to the Society.

11. The written declaration is the condition for the participation in the Contest

12. The Organizer reserves the right to exclude from the Contest the works that are not compliant with the rules of procedure of the Contest.

13. The Organizer reserves the right to change the regulations of the Contest

14. In order to take part in the Contest the persons under age have to enclose the written parents' or foster parents' agreement. (The Rules of Procedure contain the pattern of the declaration)

15. The Organizer will appoint an independent jury that will award the prizes and distinctions

16. The Organizer reserves the right to another division of the prizes.

17. The jury's verdict is irrevocable. The jury's decisions are final. The prize-winners will be informed by the Organizer by e-mail, by phone or by post.

The awarding prizes and honours with the opening of exhibition of the contest works will take place on the 16th February 2013 in Turek.

18. The participant bears the cost of his/her arrival in case he/she receives the prize.
